Winchester CC will offer a PGA Junior League Golf Teams for the 2018 season. The team will be for juniors ages 13 and younger. The carnival will serve as an introduction to the 2018 Winchester Country Club Junior Golf Program. All activities, including information on the PGA JLG team, will be presented so both parents and juniors can begin to plan their calendars for WCC golf activities.

WCC Junior Golf Team – PGA JLG

Mission Statement:

To field a 13U PGA Junior Golf League team within the WCC Junior Golf program while promoting sportsmanship, teamwork, golf knowledge, and golf skills.

Team Objectives:

1. Enable junior players to compete in tournaments and competitive matches.
2. Enhance golf skills and playing ability of junior members.
3. Improve knowledge of the rules and etiquette of golf.
4. Enable junior golfers of WCC to meet other junior golfers from other area courses/clubs.
5. Allow junior members to have fun in a “team atmosphere” while learning good sportsmanship.

Team Overview:

Golf eligible juniors of all skill levels are encouraged to participate.

- Eligible juniors must be age 13 or younger as of August 1, 2018
- Cost for the 13U PGA Junior League Golf Team will be \$150.00 for the season.
- Junior golfers must have WCC golf privileges in order to join and play with the team.

- PGA JLG Team Matches will be announced once the schedules have been made by the MAPGA Junior Golf Director.
- Additional PGA JLG Team practices may be added to the schedule as needed.
- Some matches do require travel, sometimes up to 1 hour (+/-).

Match Format:

- Each match will be played using a 2-player-vs-2-player match play, scramble format.
- There are 4 matches within each event.
- Matches are all 9-holes in length, broken into three 3-hole segments referred to as “Flags”.
- Each Flag is worth 1 point.
- The winning club will be determined by the club that wins the most flags within all of the matches played in the day’s event.
- Players may be substituted at the start of a flag allowing juniors to play the appropriate number of holes based on age and ability or to accommodate more team members in an event if greater than 8.

Team Practices

Juniors playing on the 13U team do not need prior tournament experience but they should meet or have the desire to meet the following expectations.

- Maintain proper care of the course
- Demonstrate proper golf etiquette
- Maintain proper pace of play
- Ability to play by the fundamental Rules of Golf & PGA JLG Rules
- Able to walk the course while being responsible for their clubs

Team practices will provide an opportunity for the junior team members to work on their golf skills, etiquette, and care of the course. Practices will also provide an opportunity for junior team members to receive instruction on swing fundamentals and course management. When possible, practices will be used to simulate the format played in matches on the course or practice facilities. If a junior golfer may not be ready for the formal competition of the WCC Junior Golf Team, they are still able to attend team practices and activities in order to help them achieve the ability to play in a competitive setting in the future. Juniors will have age & skill level appropriate activities to help them progress.

Custom Clinics

Custom Junior Clinics will provide the opportunity for juniors to participate in additional golf clinics beyond the clinics scheduled in the Winchester CC Junior Golf Program.

- The clinics can be specialized and have in-depth instruction or cover the basics.
- The topics of instruction will cover the appropriate needs of the participants.
- Juniors in a group of three to six participants will be able to select a professional to design and schedule a series of clinics based on the group's particular needs.
- The participants should be similar in age and ability in order to maximize the benefits of this program.
- Instruction can cover all aspects of the game including, but not limited to, course management, rules, etiquette, swing fundamentals, etc.

The fee for this program will be \$20.00 per participant, per 1 hour clinic.

Junior Golf Policies

A complete list of Winchester Country Club Regulations and Policies are provided in the Winchester Country Club Golf Book or the Winchester Country Club Regulations, Policies, By-Laws, & Roster book. The following policies pertain most directly with junior golf or are the foundations for junior golfers to understand their role in maintaining proper golf etiquette and care of the course.

1. Members’ children with golf privileges that are age 16 and under may use the golf facilities without adult, member supervision provided the junior has received authorization from the Golf Professional. Authorization from the Golf Professional will be determined on the junior’s history of golf activity and etiquette at Winchester CC including but not limited to; demonstration of proper pace of play, demonstration of proper care for the course and practice facilities, demonstration of proper golf safety practices. Unless the junior has permission from the Golf Professional Staff, children ages 16 and under shall not be permitted to use the driving range, putting green, chipping green, practice bunkers or other golf facilities unless under direct observation and control of the adult member.
2. Proper dress is required at all times on the golf course for all members, guests, and juniors. All golfers must wear a shirt with a collar and appropriate footwear. The following are not permitted: blue jeans or denim of any sort or style, cutoff shorts, athletic shorts, short shorts, T-shirts, shirts without collars, short shirts and tank tops. Players lacking proper dress will not be allowed to play, nor use the practice facility. Members are responsible for the conduct and dress of their children and guests.
3. Golf carts shall be operated by licensed drivers only.
4. Slow Play: In the interest of all, players should play without delay. Groups are expected to keep up with the group in front of them, that is, hold their position on the course. Slower groups are to invite faster groups to play through.
5. Place all trash in the proper receptacles.
6. Replace all divots in the fairway and rough. Avoid damage (taking divots) to the course during practice swings.
7. Repair all ball marks on greens and practice greens.
